Printint

- 1. Add tap water to blending concentrate to make 1 gallon (4000cc's) of blending solution. Or dilute as needed, one part concentrate to 25 parts of water.
- 2. Measure out enough blending solution to cover bottom of tray (about 4 ounces for an 8 x 10 inch print). Add color concentrates as described on the side panel, using the built-in dropper. Blend well.
- 3. Immerse print with agitation for 1 minute or more, then rinse briefly, drain and dry. Solution can be used repeatedly, and if colors lighten, add a few drops of color concentrates.
- 4. Deepen hues by increasing immersion time. Lighten by adding more blending solution.
- 5. Color can be removed by soaking print in dilute washing soda (sodium carbonate) for a few minutes. Use one tablespoon soda per gallon of water. Rinse well.
- 6. If desired to combine colors, use a masking agent such as liquid frisket or rubber cement, both sold in art supply stores. Apply frisket to areas not to be colored, dip print, rub off frisket, dip again, etc.
- 7. For a spectacular silver-on-color effect, use Printint Colorants with prints toned with Rockland Halo-Chrome Silver Toner. Printint Colorants can also be used with any sepia or blue-toned print or with Liquid Light Photographic Emulsion.
